Duration

The course is held over three days which includes travel time to our modern indoor range in Geneva, Switzerland. Course Content

- History & Introduction
- Rules of weapon handling
- Weapon familiarization and manipulations
- Close quarter combat drills
- Stance, position and grip technique
- Loading and unloading drills
- Sight picture and aiming including target and multiple target engagement
- Drawing and re-holstering drills
- Tactical reloads, speed reload and stoppage drills

Flights & Transfers:

Should you decide to opt for package one and arrange your own flights, Easy Jet and British Airways provide services from most major UK airports to Geneva Airport. Flights costs will vary depending on the time of year and will be payable by you on this package.

On arrival in Switzerland you will need to arrange and pay for your own transfers to the range / hotel and the same on completion of the course for your transfer back to the airport.

We will advise you of the flight numbers and times which those students departing from our training centre in Chorley will be taking 2 weeks prior to the course commencing. Please coordinate your flights as closely as possible to these times and check with us that you will be able to arrive in time for training before booking those flights.

Under package two all flights and transfers, both in the UK and Switzerland are included together with an additional nights' accommodation at Park Hall Hotel prior to the course commencement date. This will allow you time to meet your fellow students who you will be travelling and training with.
